



he year is 2179. Two convicts sit in the darkened cargo hold of the spaceship *Starfinder*: John Ladiver and Harry Sline. Ladiver faces execution on Earth. Food is brought to them by Bob Slater, the ship's radio-picture operator and engineer. Captain Stephen Redway also visits the prisoners. The Starfinder has run into a meteorite storm. Rocket Smith, the co-pilot, enters to inform the captain that there is smoke coming out of the radio-pic set.

Forced to land the Starfinder to make repairs, Redway chooses the nearest planet: Skaro, once the homeworld of the dreaded Daleks. Redway talks to one of his passengers, Professor Vanderlyn. He explains that after they lost the war with Earth, the Daleks are now without power and dormant. Only Thals live on Skaro now. Vanderlyn's assistant, Marion Clements, joins the crew as they explore a courtyard in the Dalek city. Rocket hangs his jacket on a dormant Dalek. Ladiver and Sline are brought to the courtyard and put to work, carrying equipment.

Slater tells Redway that somebody deliberately sabotaged the radio-pic set with iron filings. Everyone on board had the opportunity but Redway is certain it was Ladiver.

Redway demands to know why Ladiver forced them to land on Skaro. Ladiver denies any part in the sabotage. Redway



strikes him in anger and then storms off. Vanderlyn is surprised to find a crate that he doesn't recognise, despite it having his name printed on it. Ladiver cautions them against opening it. Rocket ignores him and opens it with a crowbar. It is full of dozens of metallic black boxes. Rocket notices that one of them is missing. Unnoticed by the humans, the Dalek slowly comes to life. They are stunned when it suddenly moves off up a ramp and into the city. The missing black box is on its back.

Redway tries to calm the panicking crew and civilians. Ladiver mocks Redway, and is struck again by the captain. Vanderlyn theorises that the black boxes are a new form of power source for the Daleks. Ladiver points out that he was in chains and couldn't possibly have attached the box to the Dalek. Redway accuses Ladiver of trying to control the Daleks, but the prisoner retorts that no Dalek would ever obey a human.

Redway asks Vanderlyn to help him search for the Dalek. Vanderlyn agrees and is issued with a detonator gun. He and Vanderlyn head into the city.

Ladiver argues with Rocket and Slater. Nobody notices another Dalek watching them. It disappears through a door hidden in a wall. When Sline and Ladiver are left alone, Sline compliments him on his elaborate plan. He produces another file that he stole from a toolkit.


Sline cuts through his chains and runs for freedom. Rocket shoots him with an anaesthetic bullet. Ladiver asks Rocket who was in charge of the *Starfinder's* radioscope when it flew into the meteorite storm. He points out that Redway should have been warned about the storm, but instead they were forced

Redway and Vanderlyn return from their search, having failed to find the Dalek. Suddenly the trolley containing the crate of black boxes hurtles towards everyone out of the jungle. Slater, who had been ordered to return it to the Starfinder, is nowhere to be found. A group of Daleks appear, coming down the ramp. Everyone takes cover. Redway challenges the Daleks and is quickly taken away. The other humans realise that he had the only detonator

to travel to Skaro.

gun. Ladiver notes that all the Daleks had black boxes on their backs. They open the crate to find all the boxes gone. Instead, the body of Bob Slater is inside.

Deep below ground in the Dalek city, the Black Dalek commands other Daleks to connect power cables to bring their base back to life. They wish to know if the Thals are in radio contact with Earth. The Daleks listen to the *Starfinder* crew discuss the situation. Vanderlyn has worked out that only half of the black boxes are a power source, but cannot work out the function of the other half. Ladiver suggests that they fire a flare and try to bring the Thals to their camp for help. The Daleks plan to intercept the Thals before they can reach the humans and force them to reveal the location of



STAGE DIRECTIONS


David Whitaker had specific ideas for the Thal costumes. He wrote, "Their clothes are simple and designed to suit Skaroan climate which is constantly hot. Every effort must be made by the designer to help us avoid making the Thals look like

pantomime creations. They are not. The Thals are graceful, attractive people, the simpler the clothes, the better. Basically, Ijayna should wear a skirt and not trousers. Her only adornment is the thin silver band around her forehead which encloses the top of her hair. She wears also a sleeved top, the sleeves firmly fixed at the wrists with silver cuffs. The neckline and backline of the top is square cut. The midriff is bare. The neck and backlines are also edged with silver."



THE DALEKS

Five Daleks were constructed for the play by Shawcraft, the freelance props firm that had built the Daleks for Doctor Who. Four were painted white while the fifth was black. They all had the traditional sucker arms although the script has specified that the Daleks be given claws. Peter Murphy Grumbar was the lead Dalek operator, having worked on the first three Dalek stories for Doctor Who. The Dalek voices were pre-recorded (probably by Peter Hawkins and David Graham) and played in at each performance.



their radio. Redway is brought before the Black Dalek.

An hour passes. There is no sign of the Thals but Ladiver insists they will come. Vanderlyn finally opens the other half of the black box and finds a tiny tape recorder. Vanderlyn says that Slater was killed with a hypodermic needle, meaning the killer would have to have been someone he trusted. Only Redway had the opportunity.

Suddenly a group of Thals appears from the jungle, A young woman named liayna knows Ladiver. She says that they were attacked by Daleks on their way to the city but some Thals escaped them, liayna's father Dexion is the Thal leader. He insists that Ladiver is a good man and should be released. They met three years ago when Ladiver came to Skaro on patrol. ljayna told him that someone had landed in this area. They found some proof but Ladiver couldn't convince anyone on Earth that there was a threat. He left the Space Service and created a false identity as a criminal so he could stay close to the Skaro system. The Thals free Ladiver.

Sline grabs a gun. He plans to make a deal with the Daleks with his knowledge of the Thals' location. Redway appears, badly injured. He apologises to Ladiver - he now knows he is not the traitor, but his mind feels pain when he thinks of the name of the real killer. Redway dies.

Ladiver heads off into the jungle to get to the radio. A Dalek emerges through the hidden door. Sline tries to run and is exterminated. The others are herded into the city. A door opens and the human



traitor appears, the man the Daleks call 'Master'. It is Bob Slater. He tells them that he faked his death and has already destroyed the Thal radio. Slater is insane. He has found a way to make the Daleks obev him and intends to let them conquer the universe in his name.

At Slater's command, the Daleks begin to connect their generator to the city. A Dalek pushes a trolley into the chamber containing solar batteries. Ladiver is hidden beneath it. He takes cover behind a control panel. He takes a metal band from ljayna's wrist.

The black boxes suddenly fall off the

Daleks' casings. Slater is horrified when the Daleks reveal that they were never truly his servants. They exterminate him.

Ladiver frees the other captives. They all escape except for ljayna who refuses to leave Ladiver. He pulls the main power cable free from its socket and wraps ljayna's band around it. He gives it to her and tells her to jam it into the socket. She succeeds, the power supply fades, and the Daleks fall dormant again.

Rocket races back into the chamber with a piece of metal and hits a Dalek, unaware that they have already been defeated. He strolls off as Ijayna and Ladiver kiss.

John Line played the lead character, John Ladiver: "I took my four-year-old son to see it. I can remember seeing him sitting with huge eyes, in the first row of the dress

circle. And then coming round [backstage] afterwards and going into a Dalek which was about the most momentous thing that had ever happened [to him]." There were inevitable mishaps on such a technical production. "I fell off a rostrum on the first performance which didn't matter very much because it was all part of the fun," Line recalled. "Daleks got stuck. Sometimes the light cues were a little late. You had all those natural production problems. We were very young, you know? We had a huge amount of fun. But it was really the Daleks that made it. not us!" John Line returned for Big Finish's audio adaptation of The Curse of the Daleks in 2008, this time playing Professor Vanderlyn.

THE DALEKS

(TV) by Terry Nation

The Doctor, Ian, Barbara and Susan land on Skaro, an eerie world that has been devastated by a war waged with neutron bombs. Entering a mysterious city, they are captured by strange machine-like creatures called Daleks. The travellers join forces with a pacifistic tribe of people known as Thals and defeat the Daleks.

THE DALEK INVASION OF EARTH

(TV) by Terry Nation

The TARDIS arrives in London in the 22nd century. The Doctor, Ian, Barbara and Susan soon learn that the Daleks have conquered the Earth and are using mind-controlled humans known as Robomen as a police force. The travellers aid the human resistance and overcome the Daleks. Susan falls in love with one of the resistance fighters and the Doctor leaves her behind.

THE CHASE

(TV) by Terry Nation

The Doctor, Ian, Barbara and Vicki discover that the Daleks have built their own space/time machine and are intending to pursue and kill them. A chase across the universe begins, with the TARDIS crew narrowly escaping the Daleks in New York, aboard the Mary Celeste, the planet Aridius and a strange haunted house. The final showdown takes place on Mechanus where the Daleks battle the robotic Mechanoids.



THE DALEKS' MASTER PLAN

(TV) by **Terry Nation** and **Dennis Spooner**

The Doctor, Steven and Katarina uncover a plot by the Daleks to conquer the galaxy with the aid of Mavic Chen, guardian of Earth's solar system. The Doctor steals a cylinder of taranium from the Daleks which they plan to use to power a devastating weapon called the Time Destructor. Once again, the Daleks chase the Doctor across the universe of space and time. The Doctor is aided by Space Security agents Bret Vyon and Sara Kingdom.

THE DALEKS DESTROY THE ZOMITES

(Give-a-Show Projector comics)

The Doctor, lan and Barbara land on Skaro in the TARDIS. While exploring, the trio soon find themselves under attack by intelligent insects. The Daleks arrive and destroy the insects, which they call Zomites. The Daleks tell the Doctor and his companions that the Zomites are pests and they did well to kill them. The Daleks allow them to leave, but order them to never return to their planet again.

THE DEFEAT OF THE DALEKS

(Give-a-Show Projector comics)

The Doctor and Ian have completed building a ray gun which the Doctor believes will allow them to strike back at the Daleks. Several Daleks suddenly surprise them and order them to surrender. Ian fires the gun and the Dalek named DK3 is destroyed. The Daleks retreat into their spaceship and flee. The Doctor wonders if they will return.

THE DALEKS ARE FOILED

(Give-a-Show Projector comics)

The Doctor, lan and Barbara are being chased by the Daleks. The trio find a manhole and hide underground. The Daleks decide to try their new device, an Earthman Detector. It appears to be working but the Daleks only find a cat. Believing the detector to be useless, they announce that they will destroy it as they glide away. The travellers laugh at the thought that they were saved from the Daleks by a cat.

DR WHO AND THE NERVE MACHINE

(Give-a-Show Projector comics)

lan and Barbara find the Doctor paralysed. They use the telepathic helmet and learn that the Daleks are responsible. Ian finds the Nerve Machine that the Daleks are using to control the Doctor. Ian upsets the mechanism and it begins to smoke. The Doctor recovers and thanks lan.

RESCUED FROM THE DALEKS

(Give-a-Show Projector comics)

The TARDIS lands in a Dalek laboratory. lan frees a human scientist. The man explains that he has invented a machine

that the Daleks want. A Dalek spots them, but lan throws his jacket over its tele-eye. The Doctor, lan and the scientist race back to the TARDIS before the Dalek can attack.

DR WHO AND THE DALEKS

(illustrated text story on cards)

by Cadets Sweets

The Doctor travels to the planet Marinus and is shocked to find the native Voord battling the Daleks. However, when the Daleks learn that the Voord are planning to attack Earth and claim a mysterious power, the Daleks call a truce and the two species join forces. The Doctor is captured and forced to accompany them on their mission of conquest. He manages to warn the Earth authorities of the impending invasion. The aliens are seeking a special mushroom found in South America which can grant superhuman powers.

TIME & TIME AGAIN

(comics) by **Paul Cornell** and **John Ridgway**

The Black Guardian sends the universe into chaos by altering the Doctor's history so that he never leaves Gallifrey. The Seventh Doctor, Ace and Bernice must travel to periods of the Doctor's past to repair the damage. The Seventh Doctor saves the First Doctor from a Dalek attack in London, 1963.

FUGITIVE OF THE DALEKS

(audio) by Jonathan Morris

The TARDIS arrives in ancient Carthage where the Doctor's former companion Vicki has been living for many years. She finds the Doctor injured and helps him to reach a space station. They soon find themselves being chased through time and space by the Daleks.





RETURN TO SKARO

(audio) by Andrew Smith

The Doctor, Susan, Ian and Barbara find themselves back on Skaro, decades after their first adventure. They meet the descendants of their Thal friends who have built a city. Susan and a Thal named Jyden sneak into the forbidden Dalek city, unaware that there are still Daleks alive inside it. Another Thal, Tryana, is secretly working with them.

THE DALEK OCCUPATION OF WINTER

(audio) by David K Barnes

The Doctor, Steven and Vicki arrive in the city of Winter on an unnamed planet. They find the population celebrating a new group of candidates who are about to enter a scientific research centre. They are shocked when the city's leader Majorian invites a Dalek on stage and thanks it for helping them. The travellers learn that the city is manufacturing Dalek casings and start to investigate.


ACROSS THE DARKENED CITY

(audio) by **David Bartlett**

Steven is captured by the Daleks and separated from the Doctor and Vicki. He is forced to work aboard a Dalek ship. After a prisoner revolt, the ship crash-lands on the planet Shade. Steven and a Dalek named Two-One-Zero are the only survivors. They agree to work together so they can reach a transmat station and escape the vicious Chaons.







Take the two parts of deflector strip 1, 30D and 30A. Fit them together so that the five pegs on part 30A fit into sockets on the underside of part 30D.




#030-03

Push the strip down so that the shaped brackets on part 30D fit around the screw holes on parts 29B (above/top).




#030-02

Fit the first deflector strip on to the assembly from the previous issue: to start with, position the strip above the ledges near the top of parts 29B, as indicated by the dotted line.




#030-04

Fix the deflector strip 30A/D in place with two FP screws.




#030-05

Take the two parts of deflector strip 2, 30C and 30B. Fit them together so that the five pegs on part 30B fit into sockets on the underside of part 30C.





Push the strip down so that the shaped brackets on part 30C fit around the screw holes on parts 29B (above).




#030-06

Fit the second deflector strip on to the assembly from step 4: to start with, position the strip above the ledges near the middle of parts 29B, as indicated by the dotted line.





Fix the deflector strip in place with two FP screws.


